### Overview

The Canto® Cumulus Office Extended Pack enables Cumulus to split the slides of presentations into separate asset records, each with its own metadata. Create new PowerPoint presentations from cataloged slides and images, even without PowerPoint. Extract images from OpenOffice documents into their own asset records, and more.

### Installation & Registration

This add-on module expands the functionality of a Cumulus 8.0 (or later) installation. It is already included in the Cumulus Client and Cumulus Server software. This means that it does not need to be installed separately. In order to get the full functionality, the Cumulus Administrator has to enter the corresponding license information into the License dialog of the Remote Admin module. (Add the serial number first, then register with Canto and after that replace your license information with the new one you received that will activate your Cumulus system including this new module. For a detailed description, see the Installation Guide.)
