



Canto® Cumulus Cross Client

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Overview

Cumulus Cross Client is a standalone version of the native Cumulus Client. It enables users to work with local catalogs or catalogs hosted by a Cumulus Server. Metadata and asset updates can be copied in either direction. The Cross Client is an add-on to a Cumulus Server and each Cross Client license is registered to a single computer.

All functions are also described in the help system. You can access it via the Help menu, the F1 key or the Help buttons provided in the application. Subjects are organized by contents and index, and are searchable. The help system is based on HTML pages that can be viewed with any standard Web browser. However, if you employ any pop up blockers, the display of the help system may not be possible. Deactivate the pop up blockers to have the help system displayed.

Installation

An installer application guides you through the installation process. With Windows and Mac OS X, this application is a double-click installation. The installation application lets you select a language. This language is used for the installation process as well as for the application to be installed. And the selected language also defines the names of any of the pre-configured sets installed with the software (the contents are the same for all languages but the names depend on the selected language). Detailed installation instructions can be found in the installation guide.
